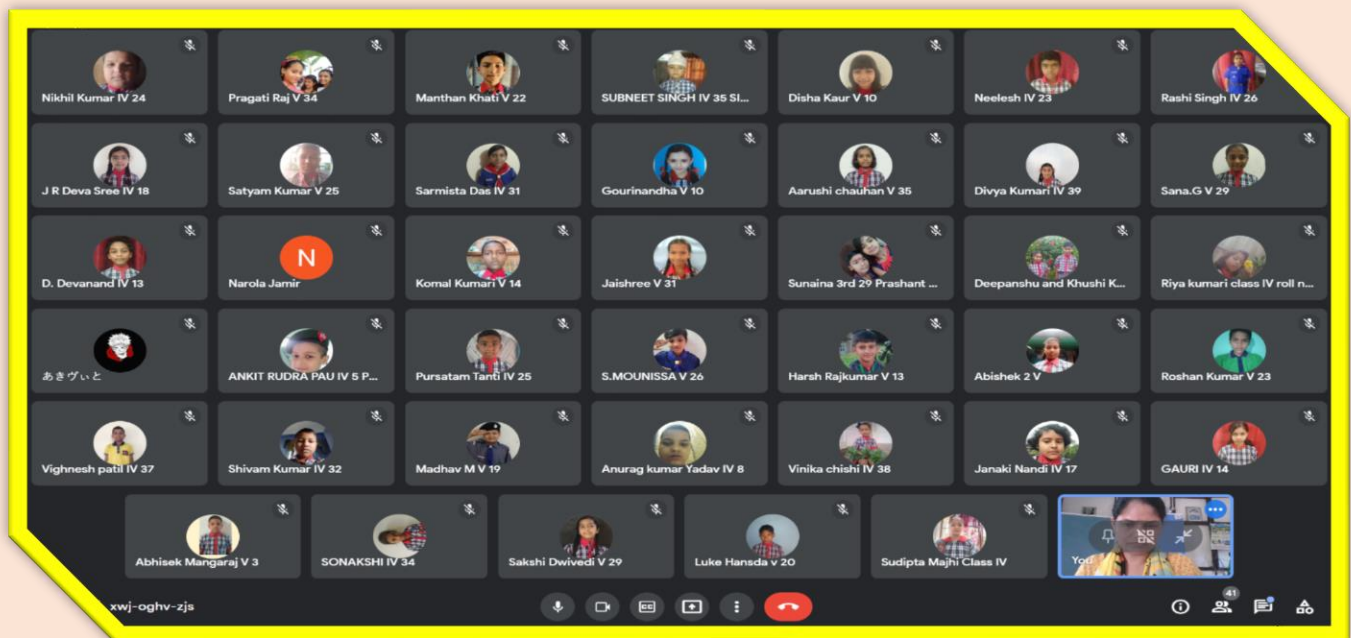
To honour these accomplishments in Science and Technology, Vidyalaya had organized Postal stamp making competition for primary students in which they had participated enthusiastically.

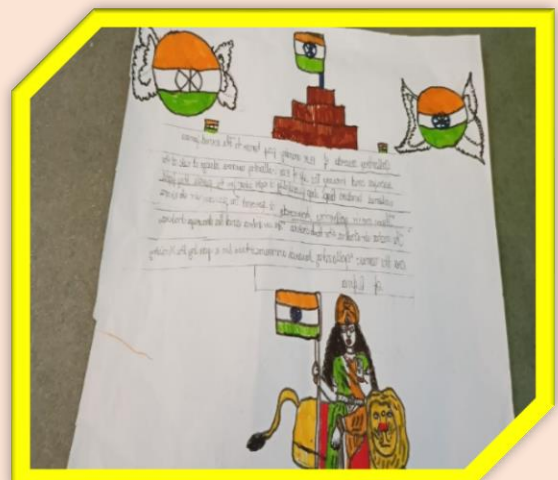
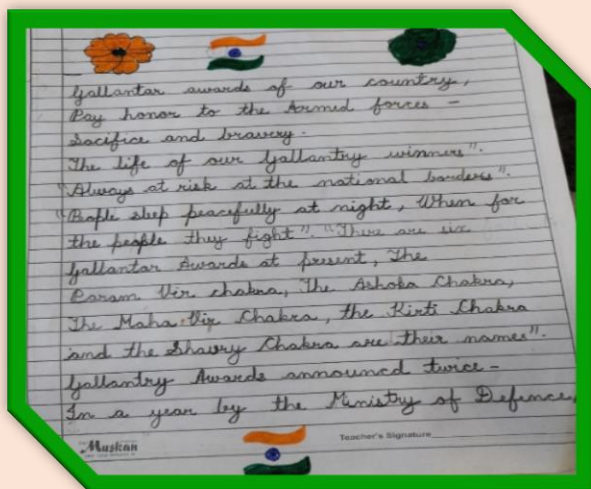
We celebrated the “National Unity Day” on 31st October 2020. Students took the pledge of unity during their online class.

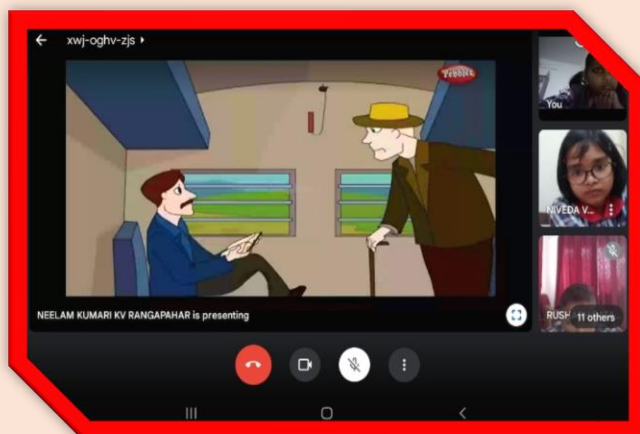
Accordingly, the Veer Gatha Project was being organized from 21st October to 20th November 2021 in which primary class students participated in poem writing and poster making competitions.



5. ACTIVITIES UNDER AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV

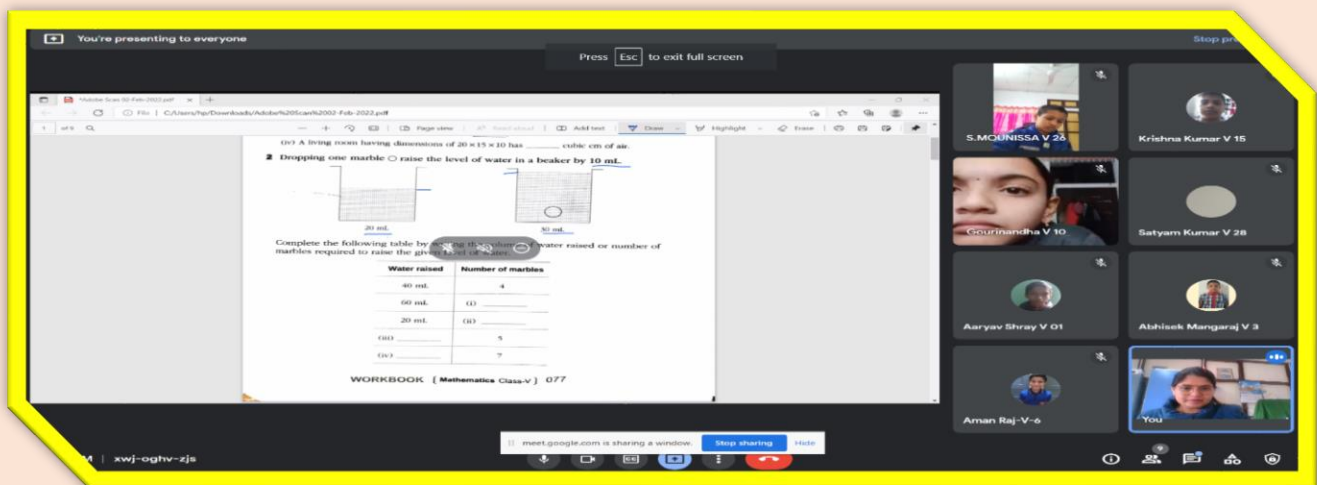
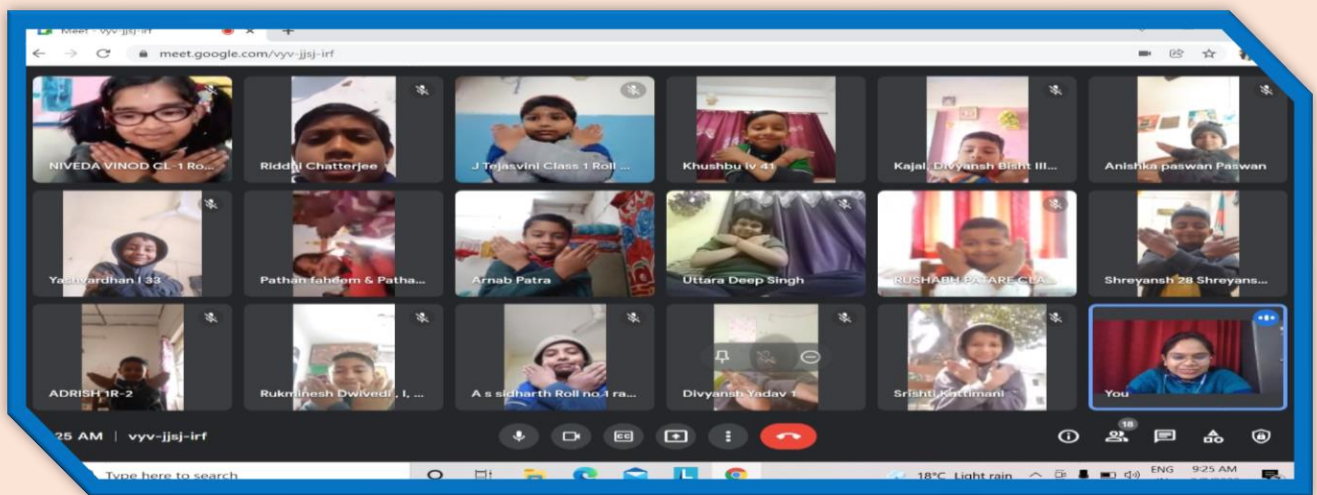
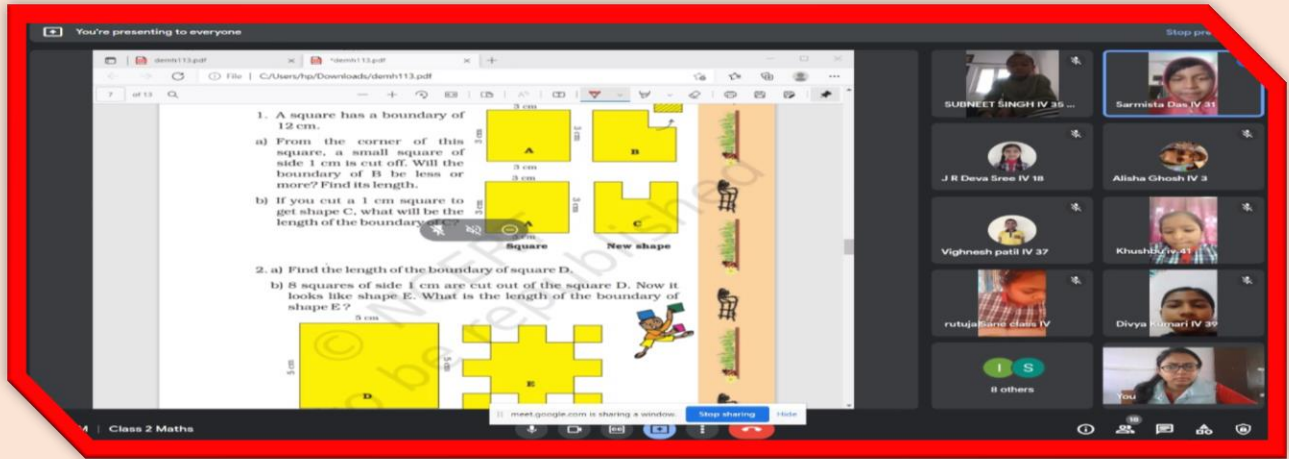
