### **ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR POSTS AT SL. No. 1 to 7**

(a) Two Year Integrated Post Graduate M.Sc. Course of Regional College of Education of NCERT in the concerned subject.

**OR**

Master's Degree from a recognized university with at least 50% marks in aggregate in the following subjects.

Sl. No.	Post (Subject)	Subject (s) at Post Graduate level
1.	PGT (Hindi)	Hindi <b>or</b> Sanskrit with Hindi as one of the subjects at Graduate level
2.	PGT (Mathematics)	Mathematics/Applied Mathematics
3.	PGT (Chemistry)	Chemistry/Bio chemistry
4.	PGT (Biology)	Botany/Zoology/Life Sciences/Bio Sciences/Genetics/ Micro-Biology/Bio-Technology/Molecular Biology/Plant Physiology provided they have studied Botany and Zoology at Graduation level
5.	PGT (English)	English
6.	PGT (Physics)	Physics/Electronics/Applied physics/Nuclear Physics

(b) B.Ed or equivalent degree from a recognized University.

(c) Proficiency in teaching in Hindi and English media.

**Note: Candidates having Special B.Ed are not eligible for the post of PGT. Desirable**

7.	PGT (Computer Science)	<b>At least 50% marks in aggregate in any of the following:</b>  B.E or B.Tech (Computer Science/ IT) from a recognized University or equivalent Degree or Diploma from an institution/ university recognised by the Govt. of India. <b>OR</b> B.E or B.Tech (any stream) and Post Graduate Diploma in Computers from a recognized University <b>OR</b> M.Sc. (Computer Science)/ MCA or Equivalent from a recognized University <b>OR</b> B.Sc. (Computer Science) / BCA or Equivalent and Post Graduate degree in subject from a recognized University <b>OR</b> Post Graduate Diploma in Computer and Post Graduate degree in any subject from a recognized University <b>OR</b> 'B' Level from DOEACC and Post Graduate degree in any subject <b>OR</b> 'C' Level from 'DOEACC' Ministry of Information and Communication Technology and Graduation.

## **ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION FOR THE POSTS AT SL. NO. 1 TO 4**

- (a) Four years integrated degree course of Regional College of Education of NCERT in the concerned subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate.

**OR**

Bachelor's Degree with at least 50% marks in the concerned subject/combination of subject and in aggregate. The elective subjects and languages in the combination of subjects are as under:

Sl. No.	POST	Subjects
1	TGT (Science)	Botany, Zoology and Chemistry.
2	TGT (Sanskrit)	Sanskrit as a subject in all the three years
3	TGT(English)	English as a subject in all three years
4	TGT(Maths)	Bachelor degree in mathematics with any 2 of the following subjects- Physics, Chemistry, Electronics, Comp. Science, Statistics

- i) B.Ed or equivalent degree from a recognized University.
- ii). Candidates pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) Paper-II, conducted by CBSE in accordance with the Guidelines framed by the NCTE.

iii) Proficiency in teaching in Hindi and English medium.

**Desirable:** Knowledge of Computer Applications.

**IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES FOR THE POST OF TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHERS (TGTs)**

**A. For the posts of TGT (Sanskrit):**

The candidate should have studied Sanskrit in all the years of graduation with atleast 50% marks in Sanskrit for the posts of TGT (Sanskrit) respectively.

**B. Special Provision:**

i) **Relaxation of B.Ed. qualification.-** In the absence of suitable candidates with B.Ed. Degrees in Hard /Very Hard station and in remote areas of North –East and J& K, candidates with following qualifications may be considered in different categories without B. Ed qualification–

- a) Post Graduate with 60% marks in Science subjects and 55% in Humanities subjects may be considered for the posts of PGTs, if suitable candidates with B.Ed. are not available
- b) Similarly in the case of TGT, B.Sc. with 60% marks and BA with 55% marks may be considered for appointment on part-time contractual basis if suitable candidates with B.Ed. are not available.
- c) Graduates may be considered for the post of Primary Teacher if candidates with Senior Secondary/Plus 2/ Inter with J.B.T. qualification are not available.

❖ **Relaxation in CTET –** In the absence of CTET qualified candidate, candidate without CTET qualification may be considered if otherwise eligible as per KVS recruitment rules.

PRIMARY TEACHER	<p><b><u>Essential:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. 1.Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) <b>OR</b> Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4-year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B. El. Ed.) <b>OR</b> Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Education (Special Education) <b>OR</b> Graduation with atleast 50% marks and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed)</li></ol> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• who has acquired the qualification of Bachelor of Education from any NCTE recognized institution shall be considered for appointment as a teacher in class I-V provided the person so appointed as a teacher shall mandatorily undergo a six month Bridge Course in Elementary Education recognized by the NCTE within two years of such appointment as Primary Teacher</li></ul> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>2. Qualified in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test</li><li>3. Proficiency to teach through Hindi and English Media.</li></ol> <p><b>Desirable:</b> Knowledge of Computer Applications.</p>

## **Selection Procedures**

1. Verification of eligibility to the post applied and certificate verification.
2. After the verification of certificates and eligibility, screening test (if required).
3. Candidates are required to attend interview.

Interview comprises of 50 marks:

- a) Teaching Experience (Maximum 10 marks): (1 Year- 2 marks)
- b) Presentation (05 marks)
- c) Subject Competency (10 marks): Candidates will be assessed in competency of their subject.
- d) Demonstration and Teaching Methodology (10 marks)
- e) Experience in Co-curricular/Sports / NCC / Scouts/ Clubs etc. activities (05 marks)

School level – 1 marks

District Level – 2 marks

Regional Level - 3 marks

National Level - 4 marks

SGFI / International - 5 marks

Max marks – 5

- f) Communication Skills (10 marks)
